Passing Clean Trays


Remember Hand Hygiene!

- 1. Clean your hands
- 2. Pick up the tray
- Knock on the door and introduce yourself
- 4. Walk in and place the tray on the table
- 5. As you walk out of the patient's room clean your hands
- 6. Pick up the next tray and repeat from #2 #6





Collecting Dirty Trays


Remember Hand Hygiene!

- 1. Clean your hands
- 2. Knock on the patient's door and introduce yourself
- 3. Walk in and pick up the tray
- 4. Walk out with the dirty tray
- 5. Place the tray in the cart
- 6. Clean your hands and repeat from # 2 #6

Gloves


Remember Hand Hygiene!
