#### **Patients in Isolation Precautions**

 Adhere to Infection Control policy when entering the patient's room who is in Contact, Droplet, or Airborne precautions.

#### **Please Note: Per Standard Precautions**

Staff should wear gloves or other PPE while performing a task beyond the patient care zone when there is reasonable anticipation that contact with blood, body fluid or an open wound may occur.


